**TRAVEL REPORT** | In 2023 we went to Ghana twice. In February to provide training in Dromankese, strengthen our network and inspect a number of Calabash Cisterns. And in November we provided refresher training in Ceera and inspected the newly build Calabash Cisterns. We have made a nice video of the construction process in Ceera. **NUMBERS** | We provided **2 training courses** in 2023, as planned. A total of **30 cisterns** have been built in various places in Ghana. If we calculate that 7 people can drink from one cistern, we have helped more than 200 people with clean drinking water in one year. And provided a dozen people with work and training. We think that has a major impact.

**A LOOK AT 2024** | We noticed that our foundation is growing. We have set up a solid network in Ghana and people are building Calabash Cisterns in several places. We see that where we used to build and train ourselves, we are increasingly working in the background. Our attention can therefore be focused on quality control and inspection. We want to go one step further in 2024. We want to increase our scale from 30 Calabash Cisterns per year to more than 100. Our ambition is great. And for that we also need more financial resources. Fortunately, we will be working closely with Wilde Ganzen in 2024. Under their wings we take the next step. On to clean drinking water for people in the rural areas of Ghana!
